

Childhood Obesity Research Conference Nov 19-20, 2009

Criteria for Posters:

Topic:

Posters will present findings from completed studies/projects which address childhood overweight/obesity. Completed work may include but is not limited to prevention and intervention trials, natural experiments, community demonstration projects, secondary data analysis, survey research, observational studies, and analysis of policy in the state of Georgia. Posters may present work completed and/or published in the past 3 years.

Content:

Each poster should have the following components:

- A. Title, Authorship (include degree credentials), Institutional affiliations
- B. Abstract - not to exceed 250 words.
- C. Background
- D. Specific Aims and Hypotheses
- E. Methods: Subjects, Methods of data collection and Statistical Analysis, indication of privacy standards and institutional approval when appropriate
- F. Results
- G. Conclusions/Discussion, including directions for future research

Eligibility for Submission:

Posters will be accepted from any individual conducting research as long as that individual has agency/institutional permission to present findings at this conference. Students should have a faculty sponsor/co-author who is responsible for institutional approvals.

Format:

No larger than 4 X 6 FT. Display boards and push pins provided. Handouts of abstract and/or poster are encouraged.

One or multiple authors will be required to be present to discuss the poster during the poster reception to take place before dinner, November 19th.

Posters will remain for viewing until the close of the conference.
