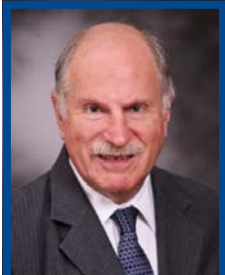

He continues to work full time and remains dedicated to teaching, research, clinical service, and community activities. The Department of Community Health and Preventive Medicine will recognize Dr. Blumenthal's accomplishments through a festschrift conference during the institution's annual observance of Public Health Day.
